Why do you think J. is so interested in lightning and why is this important to the story?

What factual information about lightning did you learn in the film? Are these facts true? How would you do research to confirm these facts?

The character J is making a film. What do you imagine this film looks and sounds like? Why?

Is there a difference between a documentary film and a fiction film? Explain.

What is "truth"? What makes something "true"?

What new insights did you gain from hearing and seeing this story?
